

Using EcoCare Activator V for general cleaning is an economical way to supplement your wastewater maintenance plan. It's an excellent household cleaner that goes to work protecting your system as it's washed down your drains.

#### FLOORS

When washing floors, spray diluted Activator V (1:50) over the floor and leave for as long as possible before washing off. Or add approx. 10 ml Activator V to a bucket of cold water and wash the floor in the usual way. Pour the bucket of water down the sink or toilet to help keep drains clean.

#### WINDOWS

Simply dilute Activator V 1:50 (10ml to a bucket of water) with cold water, spray onto windows and rinse off in the usual way.

#### MULTI-PURPOSE CLEANING

Dilute EcoCare Activator V 1:25 with cold tap water into a handy spray pack and use for all multi-purpose cleaning. Ideal for showers, bath, toilets, floors, kitchen surfaces, walls, tiles, BBQ's and other greasy surfaces etc. Rinse off with cold water.

#### ODOUR CONTROL

Dilute Activator V 1:50 with cold water and spray over any offensive waste. Great for Rubbish Bins - rinse bin with Activator V after waste has been removed or simply spray and leave – and for Pet Odour – spray over offensive area or wash down pet area.

#### CARPETS & SOFT FURNISHINGS

Dilute 1:50 with cold water, spray over spot, leave for a few minutes then dab with a damp sponge or cloth. – do not rub. Great for Pet stains too.

#### TILES & BATHROOM SURFACES

Dilute Activator V 1:25. Spray over the surface. Leave for as long as possible (eg. 10 minutes or more) then rinse off. As the water is rinsed down, your drains will also be kept free of waste build-up and unwanted odour.

#### PLEASE NOTE

Do not use other harsh cleaning products or deodorisers when using Activator V as this will reduce its effectiveness.

We recommend that the spray bottle is rinsed out and re-filled with fresh Activator V at least fortnightly.
